

# AT Homework Assignments

(Ideally) Before Session 1:

- install a local copy of the Admin Tool on a PC that you will have access to during the webinar series
- install SQL Server Management Studio

After Session 1:

1. On a PC that has the CT installed, go to the **Users** folder, visit the C:\Program Files\GRIN-Global\GRIN-Global Curator Tool and review the folders and files stored in that folder.
2. Create a user who can use the CT and the Tools option on the PW:
  - Using the Admin Tool (AT), create a CT user account.
  - Using the PW, create a PW account
  - Using the Admin Tool (AT), tie the two accounts together
3. Using the account created in #2 above, run a SQL query to display the GRIN-Global schema ("Data Dictionary"). There are multiple ways to do this:
  - copy the appropriate SQL query from the online GG SQL Library doc [see the 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph on [ [https://www.grin-global.org/sql\\_examples.htm](https://www.grin-global.org/sql_examples.htm) ] and then in a GRIN-Global Public Website where your user account has been given Web Query privileges, log in, under Tools, submit your query
  - use SQL Server Management Studio (SSMS) to run the query (again, use online SQL available via the link above)
4. Using SSMS, open the gringlobal database. Open the accession table and select 500 records to review.
